

## These are the rules for distribution of a winning Powerball Jackpot, to our Facebook Friends.

You must be our Facebook Friend at the time the winning numbers were drawn. Unless we win the Jackpot, which would be all 6 numbers, 5 white balls and the Powerball, we will not share any winnings with our Facebook friends.

We will take the amount of our tickets share of the cash distribution, and take 10% off the top to cover legal expenses, accounting expenses, clerical expenses, and other related costs. We will not be making a public accounting for that 10%. Our Adult Facebook Friends (Those 18 yoa and older, at the time of the drawing) will split the 90% of the cash distribution of our share of the winning ticket, regardless what estimated amounts were printed in the Daily Edition most previous to the drawing.

For example if the winning ticket pays \$400,000,000, and the Grand Prize Jackpot pays a cash value of \$229,000,000, the Seneca News Daily would take \$22,900,000. The remaining 90% or \$206,100,000 would be divided equally between the number of Facebook Friends listed on the main page. This doesn't include friends of friends, but only the Facebook Friends of Seneca News Daily. If we had 2108 Facebook Friends at the time of the drawing of the winning Jackpot of our numbers (04 12 24 25 50 AP PB 24 AP The formula would look like this.  $206,100,000/2108=97,770.40$

Each Facebook Friend would get a Check for \$97,770.40, or an amount allowed by law.

Any tax liability to our Facebook Friends would be their responsibility to pay. Any expense that they incur as a party receiving the distribution would be their responsibility to pay.

Shortly after the time of the win and distribution from the Lottery authority, we will share in the Seneca News Daily what would be required to receive your check. It would likely include requiring our Facebook Friends to email us at a new email address, their legal information, including a State or Federal issued picture ID, showing their current mailing address. A contact phone number for them, and if required by us to file or have, their Social Security Number.

We would allow one year from the date of the first time the instructions are printed in the SND for our Facebook Friends to comply with the instructions, even if those instructions had to be changed in subsequent Editions. After one year, their distribution would become the property of the owners of the Seneca News Daily.

Any interest earned from the money waiting to be distributed will be property of the Seneca News Daily. Our Facebook Friends would get the amount figured by the formula listed above, and not any interest on the amount derived from that formula.

The owners of the Seneca News Daily will make every effort to purchase a ticket with the numbers listed above for each drawing of Powerball. If for any reason we did not purchase the ticket and those numbers were drawn, we would not be liable for any payout, or lack thereof. If we made effort to purchase a ticket with the numbers listed above, and for any reason were given a ticket with numbers different from those listed above, we would not be held liable for that error, regardless whose error it was. If owners of the SND purchased or were given a lottery ticket with numbers different from those listed above, and were to win any amount, they would not be required to share those winning with anyone.

It is unfortunate that we needed to write out this disclaimer, but we all know if there is a large amount of money involved, some people will be blinded, making assumptions that are not valid.

If any of our Facebook Friends were to sue, and hold up distribution of the Jackpot winnings, they would instantly disqualify themselves, and their share would become property of the Seneca News Daily.

If someone has questions about these policies, they are welcome to bring them to my attention now, and we will resolve them before we win and split the Jackpot.

These guidelines were drawn up on March 23, 2014. I am glad I finally got them written up before we won, and people claimed we were unfair in the way we gave them free money. I hope someday we win, and we will have to look and see what these say. It would be serendipitous to have a large number of people connected to Tiffin, Ohio, to find themselves with thousands of dollars of unexpected disposable income.
